3-on-3 SOCCER TOURNAMENT RULES OF THE GAME REFEREE DECISIONS ARE FINAL!

The purpose of the 3-on-3 soccer is to create fun situations. Parents and coaches must understand that this tournament allows recreational players as well as select players to compete. While we try very hard to match teams with equal abilities, we have no way of knowing a team's actual level of play.

PLAYER REGISTRATION: All players must be registered on their teams' registration form before the tournament begins. Any substitutions after the team's first game, because of player's injury or emergency, must be submitted to the tournament officials before the substitute can play. The player who has been substituted can take no further part in the tournament. Tournament officials have the right to demand proof of the reason for substitution and will rule accordingly. Players can only play on one team in any age division. See Age & Team Classification on back of pamphlet for age brackets.

NUMBER OF PLAYERS: Five is the maximum number of players on a team; three field players at one time. Three players are required to begin play. There are no goalkeepers in 3-on-3 soccer. Substitutes may occur at any dead ball situation.

TEAM UNIFORMS & EQUIPMENT: All players must wear jersey/shirts during play and each team must have a light and dark shirt. All players must wear shin guards.

NO OFFSIDES IN 3-ON-3 SOCCER. NO SLIDE TACKLING: Players must stay upright "on their feet" when going into a tackle. This does not prevent players from sliding to stop/intercept a ball, but NO contact can be made with opposing players.

GOAL SCORING: After a goal has been scored, the scored upon team will restart the match with a goal kick from anywhere within the goal area or released by the goalie. There will be NO goalie drop kicks or punts. Goalie must distribute the ball by throwing or rolling the ball. If a violation is called by the referee, an indirect kick outside the goal area will be awarded to the other team. No opposing players are allowed within the goal box on a restart. A goal may be scored only from a touch within a team's offensive half of the field.

GAME DURATION: The match will be started with a drop ball at the center of the field. The referee will drop the ball no matter who is on the field. BE READY! The game shall consist of two 12 minute halves separated by a 1 minute halftime period OR the first team to reach 12 goals, whichever comes first. Games that are tied at the end of regulation play will end as a tie in the qualifying round and one (1) point will be awarded to each team. Semi-final and final games will continue with one (1) sudden death period of three (3) minutes, with a

coin toss to decide kick off/direction. If no winner emerges from the overtime period, "Sudden Death" penalty kicks will be taken until a winner is determined using the players on the field at the end of the overtime. All three (3) players must have kicked before a player takes a second penalty kick. No time-outs in 3-on-3 soccer.

PENALTY KICKS: Shall be awarded if, in the referee's opinion a scoring opportunity was nullified by the infraction. It is a direct kick taken from the middle of the halfway line with all players behind the halfway line. After the kick, the offensive team cannot touch the ball again until the defensive team has touched it.

FIVE-YARD RULE: In all dead ball situations, defending players must stand at least five yards away from the ball. If the defensive player's goal area is closer than five yards, the ball shall be placed five yards from the goal area line as the place of penalty.

KICK INS: The ball shall be kicked into play from the sideline instead of thrown in. Cannot score directly.

INDIRECT KICKS: All dead ball kicks (kick ins, free kicks, kick offs) are indirect with the exception of corner/penalty kicks.

PLAYER EJECTION: Referees have the right to eject a player from the game for continual disobedience or as a result of an incident that warrants sending off. The team may then continue with their remaining two players. The ejected player will then be suspended from the following game.

GAME SCORING: Games will be scored according to the following: 3 points for a win, 0 point for a loss.

TIEBREAKERS: In pool play, ties will be broken by 1) head to head results between the tied teams; 2) goal difference in the head to head games; 3) goals against in head to head games; 4) goals against in pool play; and 5) playoff team shootout.

Decisions by officials and the Nothing But Nets Staff are final. We reserve the right to change the rules prior to this event should we deem necessary.
